CRITERION 1: Demonstrated research excellence through academic achievements, awards, publications, significance and impact of research, and links with Government policy.

1A. List relevant education and academic achievements (no more than four) including degree, institute name and location, and date (received or expected).

1B. List relevant top five prizes, distinctions, awards and scholarships.

1C. List relevant top five publications or papers submitted for related degrees.

1D. Outline any ways in which your research may link in with any State Government policy.

CRITERION 2: Demonstrated characteristics of interdisciplinary collaboration, community engagement or support, leadership, and initiative.

2A. Please outline the top five relevant national or international associations you have been involved in and to what capacity.

2B. In 500 words or less, please address the Criterion 2 by providing specific examples.
